Elections to management posts

Two nomination forms are included with this mailing (they are also available on the website, under About Us/Annual General Meeting); one is for Management Board members, who become Trustees; the other is for all other Committee positions. Candidate profiles and voting papers will be sent to Branches on 21 September; you will be notified on the appropriate number of votes to which your Branch is entitled. Your Branch is responsible for deciding how your votes should be cast, and for completing the voting papers. Some or all of your voting papers can be submitted by post, or they can be handed in by your delegate/s on the day of the AGM, prior to the start of the meeting. Voting papers sent by post must reach Headquarters **by 26 October**.
