Some highlights from the recent RSCDS Management Board meeting

- The Board thanked staff, especially Sandra Parish, the temporary Office Manager, for their continuing hard work in the absence of an EO. The Board agreed to advertise for a permanent Office Manager, who would take on most of the EO's duties, and dispense with the EO post.
- The Treasurer reported that finances for the year were broadly on track. The Board reviewed the Society's investments.
