The stated objects of the Society shall be to advance the education of the public in traditional Scottish country dancing and in furtherance thereof: -

- (a) To preserve and further the practice of traditional Scottish Country Dancing;*
- (b) To provide, or assist in providing, special education or instruction in the practice of Scottish Country Dancing;*
- (c) To promote/publish by all available means information and music relating to Scottish Country Dancing and in particular to publish or cause to be published descriptions of Scottish Country Dances with music and diagrams in simple form and at moderate price;*
- (d) To collect books, manuscripts, illustrations and other memorabilia relating to Scottish Country Dancing and to the Society;*
- (e) Generally to do such other things as are or may be considered by the Society to be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects above stated or any of them.*

In pursuance of the above, the Society, through its branch network, offers a full range of classes and social activities. In addition, there is an annual Summer School open to members where a full range of classes are taught by experienced and enthusiastic teachers. The Society regularly publishes books of dance instructions and music, together with CDs, audio cassettes and videos. Members receive Scottish Country Dancer, the Society's magazine, twice yearly free of charge.

The Society welcomes people of all nationalities over the age of 12. Membership subscriptions may be paid:

- through the Local Association (Branch) or Affiliated Group in your area;*
- through any other Local Association (Branch) of your choice, including the International Branch, which has members in many countries;*
- direct to Headquarters (this entails an additional administrative charge).*
