

Management Board Highlights

27 June 2020

Highlights from the scheduled Management Board meeting on 27 June. All participants attended remotely. Further work on some topics is required before the Board can reach a decision so an emergency meeting will be held on 11 July.

- The auditor attended part of the meeting to comment on the Trustees' Report and Annual Accounts 2019-20. The Society reported a loss of £46,000. A reasonable outcome in the circumstances. Looking ahead the auditor was confident in the Board's projections and considered the Society a going concern.
- Further steps were put in train to cut central costs, and these will be reported more fully following the next Board meeting.
- The Board received a detailed paper from the Marketing Working Group. A paper from the *Scottish Country Dancer* Editorial Team initiated a discussion on communications. Members will have an opportunity to give their views shortly.
- With dancers beginning to meet socially again in small numbers in some parts of the world, the Board has taken advice from medical experts and is preparing some points for groups to consider as they plan a possible return to the dance floor.
- An announcement about the Autumn Gathering and AGM will be made in two weeks' time.
- The Society's Management Committees remain busy. Progress is being made on the teachers' register, the video-library and website pages for young dancers.
