

Management Board Highlights

29 June 2019

Some highlights from the recent Management Board meeting.

- The Board approved the Trustees Report and Accounts for 2018-19. Membership had increased slightly and the Society had an operating surplus of £50,000.
- A motion to reduce subscriptions by £2 will be proposed at the AGM in November with a recommendation that Branches increase their fee by a corresponding amount. This would mean no change for individual members or the overall financial position of the RSCDS, but more cash would be available to develop dancing at the grassroots.
- A survey will be conducted about the Autumn Gathering (formerly the AGM Weekend). The Board would welcome views on what branches and members want from the event.
- Clare MacGregor, our new Office Manager, was welcomed as a non-voting member of the Board.
- Janet Johnston was confirmed as a Summer School Director to replace Jim Stott in 2020. She will share the role with Anne Taylor.
- Ellie Briscoe has been appointed as an Examiner.
- The Development Fund Panel and the Jean Milligan Memorial Fund Panel will be amalgamated into a single Grant Awarding Panel with oversight of both Funds. For the moment no changes are planned to the procedures through which members and branches can apply for funding.
