

Management Board Highlights

30 May 2020

Highlights from the recent emergency Management Board meeting to deal with the impact that social distancing is having on dancing and the Society. All participants attended remotely.

- The Board is taking steps to limit the impact on the Society's finances caused by the absence of dancing during most of 2020. That impact will be felt beyond the current financial year.
- The Board is also looking ahead to a time when dancing can resume. In the meantime, it is supporting initiatives aimed at maintaining the interest of members and other dancers and musicians.
- At its next meeting in June the Board will take papers on marketing, internal communications and managing the health and safety considerations of a return to dancing. In July the Board will conduct a further review of central costs.
- The Society's Management Committees remain busy.
 - Education & Training Committee have compiled a register of RSCDS teachers and will be communicating directly with them.
 - Membership Services are leading on *Dance Scottish At Home*, preparing e-books for publication and reviewing the new members' pack.
 - Youth Services are developing an RSCDS website page for children and planning a Virtual Festival for the autumn.
- A Branch Mailing will be produced in early June with further updates on Society business, including membership renewal and the AGM.
