### **SUMMER SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM**

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## **RSCDS Scholarships**

*Scholarships are offered annually. Residential fees and examination fees (where appropriate) are covered by the Scholarships but travelling expenses are not covered.*

*The application form should be completed by the applicant, a proposer and supporter, **and accompanied** by a letter of recommendation, giving reasons for nomination, from either a Branch committee or from an RSCDS qualified teacher.*

*The Schools Subcommittee of the Education & Training Committee will be responsible for selecting the recipients from the applications received.*

**Please note:** *A Branch may submit more than one recommendation for consideration for a scholarship.*

*If successful, it is a condition of the award that a short report, maximum 500 words, must be submitted to the Education & Training Committee by 1<sup>st</sup> September in the year of the award. The report, or extracts from it, may be featured in Scottish Country Dancer or published on the RSCDS website.*

*It is also a condition of the award that your application to attend summer school must be received by 31st January in the year of attendance otherwise your award will be withdrawn.*

### **1. Teaching Certificate scholarships**

Scholarships are available for members wishing to take either Teaching Certificate part 1 or Teaching Certificate part 2. Under the terms of one of the awards, the Duncan McLeod scholarship, preference will be given to candidates undergoing teacher training, preferably in Physical Education.

2. **General Scholarships.** General scholarships are offered to Members wishing to attend Summer School as dancers, or on the Musicians' Course (including the Kitty McLaughlin Award).
  
3. **Youth Scholarships**  
Scholarships (including the Derek Haynes Award) are offered annually to Members aged 16-25 years, who wish to attend Summer School, as dancers or on the Musician's Course. Preference will be given to those in full time education who have not previously attended Summer School.
  
4. **The John Duckett Scholarship**  
One Scholarship for dancers is funded by the proceeds from the "Green Book". Preference will be given to full-time students aged 16-25 years.
  
5. **Alastair Aitkenhead Scholarships**  
Two scholarships are offered annually, one to a member aged 16 – 25 years who wishes to attend Summer School as a dancer for the first time; the second to a dancer between 12 and 16 years, preferably attending for the first time.  
**NB Both dancers must be resident on the course**

**PLEASE NOTE THAT APPLICANTS, APART FROM THE SECOND AITKENHEAD SCHOLARSHIP, MUST BE AGED 16 YEARS OR OLDER BY SUMMER SCHOOL, TO BENEFIT FROM A SCHOLARSHIP**
